A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING A
COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL BUILDING CODE
INSPECTOR, COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL PLAN
REVIEWER, AND AN ALTERNATE BUILDING CODE OFFICIAL
FOR THE BOROUGH OF WEST READING

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of West Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough") understands that the previously appointed third-party agency, Systems Design Engineering, Inc., can no longer provide building code services; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough, to maintain such coverage, desires to appoint an individual qualified under applicable Pennsylvania law to act as a building inspector and plan reviewer to enforce the provisions of all Borough Codes and Ordinances, including but not limited to the building and construction codes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of West Reading, and it is hereby RESOLVED AND ENACTED that the Borough appoints the following:

Section 1. Appointments. The following individual is appointed:

- a) Ryan M. Wessner of RMW Inspection, LLC, to serve as the Building Inspector for the Borough; and
- b) Ryan M. Wessner of RMW Inspection, LLC, to serve as the Plan Reviewer for the Borough.
- c) Ryan M. Wessner of RMW Inspection, LLC, to serve as an Alternate Building Code Official.

Section 2. Powers. The above-referenced individual is appointed to enforce the provisions of all applicable Borough Codes and Ordinances. This appointment shall include the power to inspect, issue permits, enforce, issue citations, and take other authorized legal action for the violation of such applicable codes and ordinances on behalf of the Borough.

Section 3. Revocation of Appointment. The above-referenced appointment is revocable by Council at any time.


Section 4. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions, which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.
